AN ACT

For the relief of Song Sin Taik and Song Kyung Ho.

August 25, 1967
[H. R. 7516]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, in the administration of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Song Sin Taik and Song Kyung Ho each may be classified as a child within the meaning of section 101(b)(1)(F) of that Act, upon approval of a petition filed in behalf of each by Mr. and Mrs. J. Earl Leismer, citizens of the United States, pursuant to section 204 of that Act. Section 204(c) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, relating to the number of petitions which may be approved, shall be inapplicable in this case.
