For the relief of Doctor Raquel Maria Cruz-Flores.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Doctor Raquel Maria Cruz-Flores shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of July 29, 1962.

For the relief of Doctor Josefina Esther Kouri-Barreto de Pelleya.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That, for the purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Doctor Josefina Esther Kouri-Barreto de Pelleya shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of April 14, 1961.

Private Law 90-184

AN ACT

For the relief of Our Lady of Pillar Catholic Church in Santa Ana, California.

December 18, 1967
[H. R. 1894]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That Our Lady of Pillar Catholic Church in Santa Ana, California, is relieved of liability to the United States in the amount of \$505.80, representing its liability to the United States because of an inadvertent violation of a restriction regarding the use of donated property which Our Lady of Pillar Catholic Church received under the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949. In the audit and settlement of the accounts of any certifying or disbursing officer of the United States, credit shall be given for amounts for which liability is relieved by this section.
