Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring),
That there be printed as a House document, and for the use of the Committee on Education and Labor, four thousand five hundred and eighty additional copies of the study entitled, "Study of the U.S. Office of Education," prepared by that committee; and there be printed five thousand four hundred and twenty additional copies, of which four thousand three hundred and ninety copies shall be for the use of the House of Representatives and one thousand and thirty copies shall be for the use of the Senate.

SEC. 2. Copies of such document shall be prorated to Members of the Senate and House of Representatives for a period of sixty days, after which the unused balance shall revert to the respective Senate and House Document Rooms.
