To designate the United States Post Office and Federal Building in Griffin, Georgia, the "John J. Flynt, Jr. Federal Building".

Designation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,* That the United States Post Office and Federal building located in Griffin, Georgia, is hereby designated as the "John J. Flynt, Jr. Federal Building". Any reference in any law, regulation, document, record, map, or other paper of the United States to such building shall be considered to be a reference to the "John J. Flynt, Jr. Federal Building".

Effective date.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect on January 4, 1979.
