An Act

To designate the United States Federal Building in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, as the "William S. Moorhead Federal Building".

Oct. 9, 1980

[H.R. 8161]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the United States Federal Building located at 1000 Liberty Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, shall hereafter be known and designated as the "William S. Moorhead Federal Building". Any reference in any law, map, regulation, document, record, or other paper of the United States to that building shall be held and considered to be a reference to the "William S. Moorhead Federal Building".
