

territorial integrity of Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania, and

(iii) strict observance of the principle of nonintervention by one sovereign state in the internal and external affairs of another sovereign state.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Senate shall transmit a copy of this concurrent resolution to the President.

## ADJOURNMENT—HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATE

Feb. 9, 1984  
[H. Con. Res. 255]

*Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate concurring),* That when the House adjourns on Thursday, February 9, 1984, it stand adjourned until 12 o'clock meridian on Tuesday, February 21, 1984, and that when the Senate adjourns on Thursday, February 9, 1984, or on Friday, February 10, 1984, pursuant to a motion made by the majority leader in accordance with this resolution, it stand adjourned until 12 o'clock meridian on Monday, February 20, 1984.

SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the majority leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with the minority leader of the House and the minority leader of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.

## DAYS OF REMEMBRANCE OF VICTIMS OF THE HOLOCAUST— CAPITOL ROTUNDA CEREMONY

Feb. 29, 1984

Whereas pursuant to the Act entitled "An Act to establish the United States Holocaust Memorial Council", approved October 7, 1980 (94 Stat. 1547), the United States Holocaust Memorial Council is directed to provide for appropriate ways for the Nation to commemorate the Days of Remembrance of Victims of the Holocaust, as an annual, national, civic commemoration of the Holocaust, and to encourage and sponsor appropriate observances of such Days of Remembrance throughout the United States;

Whereas pursuant to such Act, the United States Holocaust Memorial Council has designated April 29, 1984, through May 6, 1984, as "Days of Remembrance of Victims of the Holocaust"; and
