This matter is before the court on a *Petition for Permission* to Appeal filed by both the appellant and appellees in the underlying Bankruptcy Appellate Panel proceeding. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 158(d)(2).

The petition for permission to appeal is granted. Pursuant to Judicial Conference policy, when a direct appeal is authorized, the appellant shall pay only the difference between the circuit filing fee and the Bankruptcy Appellate

Panel fee. Accordingly, Wells Fargo shall pay \$200 to the clerk of the bankruptcy court within 10 days of the date of this order. The date of this order shall serve as the date of the notice of appeal. *See* Fed. R. App. P. 5(d)(2).

The clerk is directed to open a new appeal forthwith. The parties will be notified how to proceed in separate directives issued in the new appeal.
