ORDER

This matter is before the court on Appellant's failure to file a petition to proceed pro se, in accordance with the court's April 29, 2010 order. Our April 29 order directed Appellant to file within 14 days a fully compliant petition for leave to proceed pro se in light of the filing restrictions order entered in *Maske v. Murphy*, No. 09-1536, 2010 WL 529801 (10th Cir. Feb. 16, 2010).

The April 29 order advised Appellant that any defect in compliance with the filing restrictions would be grounds for dismissal for failure to prosecute pursuant to Tenth Circuit Rule 42.1. (4/29/10 Order at 2.) Appellant initially submitted numerous letters to this court. We notified him by order dated May 5, 2010, that these letters did not satisfy the requirements of a petition to proceed

pro se. He has since submitted additional letters, but none complies with the filing restrictions. *See Maske v. Murphy*, No. 09-1536, 2010 WL 529801 (10th Cir. Feb. 16, 2010). The time to file a compliant petition has expired. Therefore, this appeal is dismissed for failure to prosecute. 10th Cir. R. 42.1. A copy of this order will stand as the mandate of the court.
