ORDER

Before **KELLY, O'BRIEN**, and **TYMKOVICH**, Circuit Judges.

Mr. Hill has filed a notice of appeal from the district court's judgment of dismissal, entered on March 21, 2012. Based upon Mr. Hill's response to this court's show cause order of June 14, 2012, and based upon a review of the file as a whole, the court concludes that this appeal is untimely.

Pursuant to Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(1)(A) (30 days for filing a notice of appeal in a civil case), Mr. Hill's notice of appeal was due on or before April 20, 2012. It was not filed until June 8, 2012. This court cannot grant an extension of time for filing a notice of

appeal. See Fed. R. App. P. 4 (a)(5) and *Alva v. Teen Help*, 469 F.3d 946, 950 (10th Cir. 2006).

Because the notice of appeal was untimely, this court lacks jurisdiction to consider this appeal. *Bowles v. Russell*, 551 U.S. 205 (2007).
