This court lacks jurisdiction over this appeal.

The plaintiff appeals orders entered by a magistrate judge pertaining to pre-trial matters as well as an order denying a motion for a change of venue. This is not appealable to this court. Except for proceedings conducted by the magistrate judge on consent of the parties pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), a court of appeals lacks jurisdiction

to hear an appeal taken directly from a decision of a magistrate judge. *See Colorado Building & Construction Trade Council v. B.B. Andersen Construction Co.*, 879 F.2d 809 (10th Cir. 1989). Moreover, the orders, even if entered by the district court judge, were not final or otherwise immediately appealable. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1291.
