PER CURIAM:

James J. Royal appeals the district court's orders granting Defendants' summary judgment motions on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) deliberate indifference to dental needs claims, and denying his Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e) motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's orders. Royal v. Bassett, 7:08-cv-00222-jlk-mfu (W.D.
