Carolyn Annette Waker appeals the district court's order dismissing her Americans with Disabilities Act complaint, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 12101-12213 (West 2005 & Supp. 2009), for failure to timely respond in accord with the court's notice of December 3, 2009.
