PER CURIAM:

Alphonzo Craighead appeals the district court's order dismissing without prejudice in part and with prejudice in part his Fair Credit Reporting Act, 15 U.S.C. §§ 1681-1681(u) (2006) and Virginia state law claims against Nissan Motor Acceptance Corporation. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Craighead v. Nissan Motor Acceptance Corp., No. 1:10-cv-00981-JCC (E.D. Va. Dec. 14, 2010).
