PER CURIAM:

William Reid Black appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing, under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2012), Black's complaint filed pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Black v. U.S. Army, No. 1:13-cv-00889-NCT-LPA (M.D.N.C. Jan. 23, 2014).
