15 It is hereby stipulated between the parties, Plaintiff United
16 States of America, by and through United States Attorney McGregor W.
17 Scott and Assistant United States Attorney Jill Thomas, and
18 Defendant Arturo Farias-Segura through his attorney Diana L. Weiss,
19 as follows:

20 Defendant Farias-Segura and the United States submit that the
21 ends of justice are served by the Court excluding such time, in
22 order to permit the counsel a reasonable time for effective
23 preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. 18
24 U.S.C. § 3161(h) (8) (B) (iv). In particular, defense counsel has
25 recently received the initial discovery in this matter and
26 additional time is needed to review the discovery. There is also
27 additional discovery outstanding that has yet to be produced to the
28 defendant, including wiretap recordings. The parties stipulate and

1 agree that the interests of justice served by granting this
2 continuance outweigh the best interests of the public and the
3 defendant in a speedy trial.

4 It is agreed that the status conference date of June 20, 2008
5 be vacated and that a new status conference date of June 27, 2008,
6 at 9:00 a.m. be set.
