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It is hereby stipulated and agreed to between plaintiff, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, through its counsel of record, Matthew C. Stegman, Assistant United States Attorney, and defendant DUANE ALLEN EDDINGS, through his counsel of record, Joseph J. Wiseman, that the status conference scheduled for April 26, 2011, at 9:30 a.m., be rescheduled to May 10, 2011, at 9:30 a.m.

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The parties further stipulate and agree that a continuance is appropriate in this case and request that the time beginning April 26, 2011, and extending through May 10, 2011, be ordered excluded from the calculation of time under the Speedy Trial Act. The ends of justice will be served by the Court excluding such time, so that the

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attorneys may have reasonable time necessary for effective 1 2 preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. 18 3 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7). The government has informed defense counsel that it is awaiting 4 5 approval from the Tax Division of the United States Department of Justice before moving forward on criminal tax charges. It is 6 7 expected that a superseding indictment charging additional crimes such as tax evasion and bankruptcy fraud will be returned. Defense 9 counsel will then need additional time to review and consider these 10 additional charges before setting this case for trial.
