Major Duties

Serve as a Federal Police Officer on one of two 12-hour shifts. Responsible for enforcing the laws, deter crime, apprehending criminals, and respond to citizen complaints and requests for help.

Major activities include; vehicle and foot patrols, vehicle inspections, access control, perimeter checks, oversight of personnel conduct, and deterring criminal activity through random antiterrorism measures, thereby promoting the safety and security of GPO employees, the public and designated GPO facilities and operations.

Qualifications

Must have one of the following:

- Possess 52 weeks of specialized experience equivalent to the next lower grade level.
- Completion of full 4 year course of study leading to a Bachelor's degree in Police Science or a comparable degree program related to the work of position.
- Applicants may substitute education for experience or combine education and experience with specialized experience to meet minimum qualification for this position. Successful completion of a federal, state, county, or municipal police academy or comparable course that included at least 40 classroom hours of instruction in police department procedures and methods.

Selection Process

- Oral Interview
- Psychological Exam
- Background Investigation
- Medical Exam/Drug Testing
- Physical Fitness Test
- Valid Driver's License at time of appointment
- FLETC Uniformed Police Training Program
- New Officer Training Program



Training and Firearms Requirement

Appointed GPO Police Officers are given a 12-week intensive course of training at FLETC in Glynco, Georgia, in all phases of law enforcement. Included are courses in crisis intervention, officer safety and survival, patrol techniques, radio communication, report writing, criminal law, arrest techniques, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, defensive tactics, defensive driving, etc. Successful completion of this training in addition to DC Criminal Code is mandatory.

Complete the application package which includes;

1. Occupational Questionnaire
2. Resume or OF-612
3. Optional Application for Federal Employment
4. Any other documents needed to verify your qualifications (ex. DD-214)
