SUBJECT: Rider Requisitions for the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO) “*Standards for Internal Control in the Federal Government*”, commonly known as the Green Book.

The Government Printing Office (GPO) is now accepting rider orders for the Government Accountability Office (GAO) 2014 revision of *Standards for Internal Control in the Federal Government*, commonly known as the Green Book. The new document supersedes the November 1999 revision. No printed copies will be available through GAO, however this publication will be available on GAO's Website.

The estimated rider rate is approximately \$1.50 each, which applies to single destination, local delivery. Mailing charges, if incurred, will be added to your account.

Send requisitions to GPO by **August 25, 2014**. Please be sure to indicate GPO Jacket No. 386-047, Requisition No. 4-00023, on your requisition. The preferred method of submitting requisitions is to e-mail them to requisition@gpo.gov with the Jacket Number in the Subject line. If you cannot e-mail requisitions, they may be faxed to 202-478-1762 or mailed to Agency Publishing Services COMSTAT, Stop CSA, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, DC 20401. Field or regional activities should coordinate their requirements with their Washington, DC area headquarters' printing officers before submitting any paperwork.
