SUBJECT: Rider Requisitions for *OMB Statistical Programs of the U.S. Government, Fiscal Year 2015*

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has issued a letter to agency Requisition Officers announcing the opportunity to submit rider orders for the *OMB Statistical Programs of the U.S. Government, Fiscal Year 2015*. We are distributing this information by Circular Letter to help ensure that agencies receive this information in a timely manner.

This report fulfills OMB's responsibility under the Paperwork Reduction Act to report annually to Congress on the status and budget for each major statistical program. The report provides information on more than 80 agencies that have budgets of \$500,000 or more for statistical activities for FY 2013, FY 2014, or FY 2015. Chapter 1 highlights Congressional action on the President's FY 2014 budget request and the President's proposed FY 2015 funding for statistical activities. The chapter also includes information about statistical work performed by agencies on a reimbursable basis and about agency purchases of statistical services and projects. Chapter 2 presents significant changes proposed for Federal statistical activities in the FY 2015 budget. Chapter 3 provides information on plans for improving Federal statistical programs.

The estimated rider rate is \$2.00 per copy, which applies to single destination, local delivery. Mailing charges, if incurred, will be added to your account.

Send requisitions to GPO by **October 3, 2014**. Please be sure to indicate GPO jacket No. 386-620 and OMB Requisition Number 4-000018-G4F018 on the SF-1 form. The preferred method of submitting requisitions is to e-mail them to requisition@gpo.gov with the jacket number in the subject line. If you cannot e-mail requisitions, they may be mailed to Agency Publishing Services, COMSTAT, Stop CSA, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, DC 20401. Field or regional activities should coordinate their requirements with their Washington, DC, area headquarters' printing officers before submitting any paperwork.
