U.S. Government Printing Office Pueblo Distribution Center (PDC) Pueblo, CO

- Established October 1971
- PDC was given its own ZIP code, 81009.
- 60,000 square foot climate controlled warehouse.
- Multiple loading docks.
- Over 2,100 pallet storage locations.
- Fulfilled over 106 million orders.
- Distributed over 1 billion publications.



U.S. Government Printing Office Laurel Distribution Center (LDC) Laurel, MD

- Established in 1975
- 104,000 square foot climate controlled warehouse.
- Multiple loading docks.
- Over 3400 pallet storage locations.
- Secure facility with badge only access.
- Skilled operators to handle products.



Customer Success Stories

- **Client:** 2014 Federal Trade Commission (FTC).
- **Issue:** FTC wanted to continue the production and distribution (more than 1 million copies) of the NET CETERA Promotion, but had a mandate to reduce both printing and distribution costs by 10%.
- **Objective:** Find a solution that would meet FTC's distribution needs and their 10% cost saving mandate.
- **Solution:** Implement a warehouse solution that will divide the orders into two groups for distribution; East (LDC) and West (PDC) of the Mississippi River.
- **Result:** FTC saw a 34% reduction in transportation costs, decreased delivery/in-transit time by 2.5 days, while meeting FTC's mandate of a 10% cost reduction; which culminated in an ongoing successful promotion.

Customer Success Stories



- **Client:** 2013 Federal Acquisition Service General Services Administration (FAS/GSA).
- **Issue:** Due to budget restrictions and reductions, FAS/GSA needed to find a way to reduce cost in their warehousing and distribution services.
- **Objective:** Work with FAS/GSA to find a cost saving solution that will allow them to continue with their worldwide distribution services of their publications.
- **Solution:** After conducting a cost analysis, GPO recommended for FAS/GSA to outsource their warehousing and distribution services to GPO. This would allow FAS/GSA to continue their distribution services and still meet their budget requirements.
- **Result:** FAS/GSA saved over \$240,000 annually through cost reductions in shipping costs, lease costs, utilities, head count and etc...by closing their facility and relocating it to GPO.
