NEW "PLUM BOOK" AVAILABLE FROM GPO

The 2000 edition of *United States Government Policy and Supporting Positions*, better known to Federal job seekers as the "Plum Book," is available from the Government Printing Office (GPO).

Issued every 4 years just after the Presidential election, the "Plum Book" includes a listing of those positions throughout the Federal Government that may be subject to non-competitive appointment. There are over 7,000 positions listed in this year's "Plum Book." The "Plum Book" is published alternately by the Senate Committee on Governmental Affairs and the House Committee on Government Reform. This year the responsibility fell to the Senate Governmental Affairs Committee, and the "Plum Book" was issued as Senate Print 106-54.
