## THE BUDGET OF THE U.S GOVERNMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 AVAILABLE ON GPO'S FEDERAL DIGITAL SYSTEM

WASHINGTON—The U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) makes available the authentic, electronic version of President Barack Obama's Budget for FY 2010 on GPO's Federal Digital System (FDsys). GPO authenticated the document by digital signature. This signature assures the public that the document has not been changed or altered. A digital signature, viewed through the GPO Seal of Authenticity, verifies the document's integrity and authenticity.

GPO employees also worked around the clock to make available the printed version of the President's Budget. GPO worked with the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to distribute copies of the Budget to the public and media.

"GPO employees are honored to provide the American people the authentic printed and electronic versions of the President's Budget," said Public Printer Bob Tapella. "GPO is committed to providing Americans transparency on the workings of their government. The public can be assured; documents from GPO are authentic, which maintains the chain of custody from author to end user has been not been changed."

GPO launched FDsys early this year. This system gives the American people a one-stop site to authentic, published government information. FDsys allows GPO to receive information from federal agencies in all three branches of government and create a repository for permanent, public access. More than 154,000 documents are currently accessible, with additional documents being added daily. FDsys offers incredible search capabilities for users such as: searching by Congressional Committee, a Member of Congress, keyword and date. FDsys will replace *GPOAccess* in mid-2009 and releases with additional functionality will occur throughout the next several years.

The GPO is the Federal Government's primary centralized resource for gathering, cataloging, producing, providing, authenticating, and preserving published U.S. Government information in all its forms. GPO is responsible for the production and distribution of information products and services for all three Branches of the Federal Government. In addition to publication sales, GPO makes government information available at no cost to the public through *GPO Access* ([www.gpoaccess.gov](http://www.gpoaccess.gov)), and through partnerships with approximately 1,250 libraries nationwide participating in the Federal Depository Library Program.
