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PUBLIC PRINTER ANNOUNCES SEVENTH CONSECUTIVE YEAR OF POSITIVE RESULTS

WASHINGTON--The U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) is reporting a seventh consecutive year of net operating income for its fiscal year 2010 results. The unaudited financials show GPO completed the year with a net operating income of \$7.9 million on total revenues of \$928 million, excluding Other Operating Income of \$290 thousand for an adjustment to GPO's long term workers' compensation liability.
