SENATE RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MILITARY FORCE AGAINST SYRIA AVAILABLE ON GPO'S FEDERAL DIGITAL SYSTEM

WASHINGTON – As the U.S. Congress debates the United States' potential use of military force against Syria for the use of chemical weapons, the U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) makes the authentic, digital version of the Senate resolution available on the agency's Federal Digital System (FDsys). As reported by the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations on September 6, the resolution's title is: *S. J. Res. 21 PCS, Authorization for the Use of Military Force Against the Government of Syria to Respond to Use of Chemical Weapons*. GPO authenticated the document by digital signature. This signature assures the public that the document has not been changed or altered. A digital signature, viewed through the GPO Seal of Authenticity, verifies the document's integrity and authenticity.

GPO provides for permanent public access to Federal Government information at no charge through our Federal Digital System (www.fdsys.gov), partnerships with approximately 1,200 libraries nationwide participating in the Federal Depository Library Program, and our secure online bookstore.
