KERRY L. MILLER APPOINTED ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

Public Printer Michael F. DiMario has announced the appointment of Mr. Kerry L. Miller as the Administrative Law Judge at the Government Printing Office (GPO), effective March 1, 1999.

In this capacity, Mr. Miller will head GPO's Board of Contract Appeals, which considers and determines the outcome of appeals from the final decisions of GPO contracting officers. Most matters before the Board arise from GPO's Printing Procurement Program, under which approximately three quarters of all work ordered through GPO is contracted out to private sector firms. In FY 1998, GPO procured approximately \$467 million worth of printing jobs from the private sector. Mr. Miller has been the Associate General Counsel (Contracts and Procurement), GPO's senior procurement law attorney, since 1987.

In announcing Mr. Miller's appointment, Public Printer DiMario, who served as GPO's Administrative Law Judge from 1985-90, said, "Kerry Miller has repeatedly demonstrated superior skills, knowledge, and experience in the field of Government contract law, and I have the greatest confidence in his abilities. He will make an excellent Administrative Law Judge."

Mr. Miller received his law degree in 1981 from Catholic University and his undergraduate degree from George Mason University in 1977. He began his Government career with GPO in 1981 as Assistant General Counsel where he primarily practiced before the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and the Merit Systems Protection Board defending Federal employee appeals. He also served as GPO's ethics officer from 1985 to 1988.

Mr. Miller is licensed to practice law in both Virginia and the District of Columbia. He is a member of the bars of several U.S. District Courts, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit, the U.S. Court of Federal Claims, and the United States Supreme Court. He is a member of the Federal Bar Association's Capitol Hill Chapter, the Computer Law Association, and the Boards of Contract Appeals Bar Association.

Mr. Miller and his wife Myrna reside in Alexandria, VA, with their two sons, Alexander and Eric.
